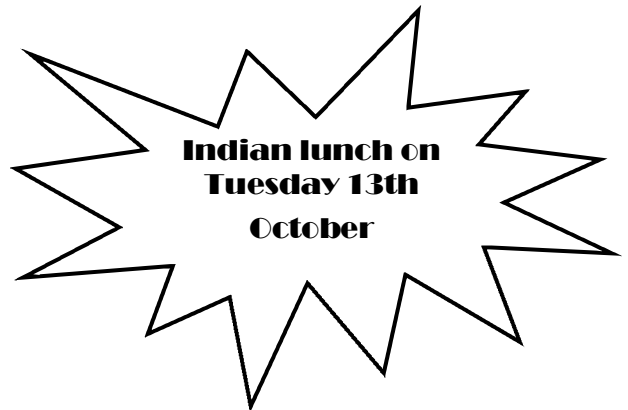
E-safety Assembly
