Congratulations to year 5 and 6 football and netball teams who were first and second in their cluster of schools. Good luck in the finals!

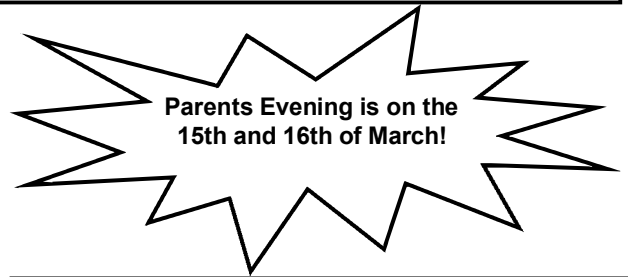
New School
